



Riding from the property you can choose from a wide variety of tested routes that cater to all levels. Terrain ranges from rolling valley and flatter Garonne river roads to legendary Tour cols, including the Portet d'Aspet, Menté, Peyresourde, Port de Balès, Hautacam, Aubisque and the Tourmalet.

We would be delighted to host you for a unique experience that includes fully mapped rides, pro-style cycling support, luxurious accommodations, fine dining and more.





CYCLING AND THE CHATEAU

For a long time the Chateau has been welcoming cyclists coming from around the world on holidays with their family and friends.



In 2017, Chateau de Saint-Martory partnered with Chris Gutowsky, former US National Champion and founder of Velosport Consulting, to offer specialized services ranging from route selection to full trip organization.

In 2022, the Chateau became the European base for Cynisca Cycling, a newly founded American women's team. As part of this new venture, we built a professional Service Course to match the team's requirements. It includes a secure bike storage space and top of the line workshop and tools that are now available to all our cycling guests.

Today the Chateau is the most exclusive location for refined cyclists wishing to ride the Pyrénées.





A WONDERFUL STAGE TO ESCAPE THE MODERN WORLD

Chateau de Saint-Martory is a beautifully restored, fairytale castle from the Renaissance, located 45 minutes away from Toulouse International Airport in South West France.

The chateau stands high on the banks of the Garonne river, with the Pyrénées mountains at close range. It is surrounded by historical rural buildings and beautiful woods.

The 40-hectare property is always leased on an exclusive basis for cycling groups, weddings, holidays and corporate retreats.





FIVE LIVING SPACES



The Chateau offers five very distinct living spaces including the historical guards' room, the classical red lounge, yellow dining room and office, and the contemporary games room.

The stones of the guards' room have been carved and polished by the passing of time and men. It is an untouched space where time seems to have come to a halt centuries ago.

The massive fireplace has witnessed countless moments of gastronomical delight, and is still used for joyful winter barbecues.



The red lounge is the place to enjoy a cup of tea or a glass of Porto after a day outdoors. Its warmth is the direct result of Viollet le Duc's reinterpretation of gothic style mixed with the romanticism of the 1850's.




The French Billard will be late evening entertainment while enjoying a glass of Armagnac produced by our very own cousins, the Delords.

The Farmhouse across the lawn offers one suite and two bedrooms.


The Gatehouse itself was fully redone in 2021 and includes one suite.

Six additional suites will be available in 2024 in the nearby relais du Chateau located in the village, bringing total capacity to 17 rooms.

All the rooms have been decorated personally by the owner through years of searching in antique shops, fairs and flea markets and also at auctions.

Gradually, modern "deco" and contemporary art made their way into the Chateau in striking harmony with old master paintings and classic furniture.




The 1850's farmhouse overlooks the chateau and the gardens and offers three guest-rooms, which have been fully renovated in 2020.

The farmhouse courtyard and the open barn are also where we host large events.














The gatehouse is a typical example of the mid XIX century gothic revival.

Built originally to host the property's caretaker it was completely refurbished in 2021.

From the the gatehouse our guests enjoy beautiful views of the the Garonne river and the national heritage bridge.




Our private chef offers local French cuisine, accompanied by great wines from our cellar.


One evening is generally reserved for the "all cheese & wine" tasting experience.

BIKE FACILITIES






EASY WELCOME LOOP

GARONNE RIDE 1: 27 MILES, 1230 FT

Looping along and near the Garonne River to the northwest and Cazères. Flat to rolling, with several small hills of 100-200ft.


SERIOUS WARM-UP

RIVER VALLEY LOOP N°2: 58 MILES, 3650 FT

A long «double-loop» to the north, this route provides good options for groups of varied fitness. Several long ridge-top roads offer wonderful views.

And the midpoint town of Aurignac is a great place for a quick coffee stop, or even lunch on the road.




TDF COLS

CORE WORKOUT: 86 MILES, 8130 FT

After a flat warmup to Saint Girons, the route climbs to and over the isolated Col de la Core.

This challenge is soon followed by the shorter but better known Col de Portet Aspet, then a downhill profile finish.









THE PROPERTY OFFERS MANY POSSIBILITIES

Whether you like ping pong, darts, archery, or croquet, there will always be something to do while staying on the property.

In addition, bespoke orienteering races, Yoga or Tibetan bowl sessions are very easy to organize.

The pool is located on a parcel of land surrounded by an ancient stone wall. It is contiguous to, but hidden from the Chateau, which gives it a special peaceful and secluded feeling.

The pool-house, previously a greenhouse, includes a fully equipped kitchen. It is possible to prepare and serve lunch for 20 guests at the pool, especially with the help of the Argentinian BBQ. Our guests enjoy relaxing on one of our many loungers after a ride or on a day off.

On the same parcel the Chateau's orchard offers its fruit from June until October.

- Tennis (in the village of Saint-Martory)


Cultural visits in the surrounding region are also a must, along with discovering local vineyards and Armagnac producers.




A WORD FROM THE OWNER
